Fiscal Impact

None at this time. However, the reduction and/or elimination of irrigation water on irrigated lands in Mono County, if implemented, will negatively impact the County's economy, jobs, and tax base.

Discussion

At its April 10th meeting, this Board heard from ranchers in Southern Mono County regarding proposed leases which they received from the Los Angeles Department of Water and Power (LADWP) for existing agricultural operations in Mono County. The proposed new leases would completely eliminate both irrigation and stock water, essentially making those operations infeasible. The impacts of this proposal, besides direct impacts to the lessees include damage to wetland habitat, wildlife (including the bi-state sage grouse), and the loss of a part of the cultural heritage and tradition of Mono County. At the April 10th meeting, the question of LADWP's compliance with the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) prior to making this significant change was discussed. Subsequently, LADWP staff informally notified ranchers that they planned to conduct environmental review related to the new leases and that those ranchers could continue to operate under their prior leases this season, but with significantly less water than has historically been provided. The amount proposed is insufficient to sustain current operations.

Staff met with several ranchers on Monday, April 16th to discuss the best approach(es) to address this potentially devastating change to Mono County's agricultural economy and natural environment. The result of that discussion is a draft letter which will be presented at the meeting for consideration and potential approval by your Board today.
