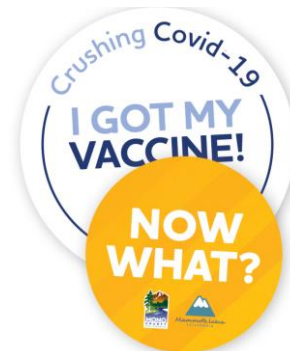




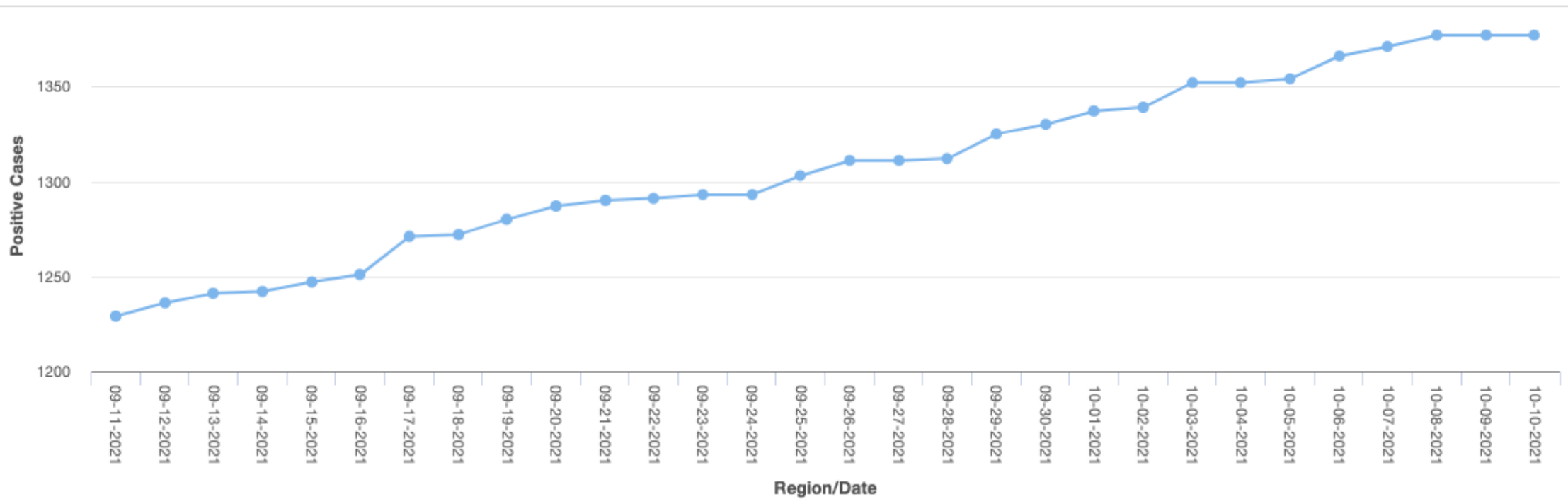

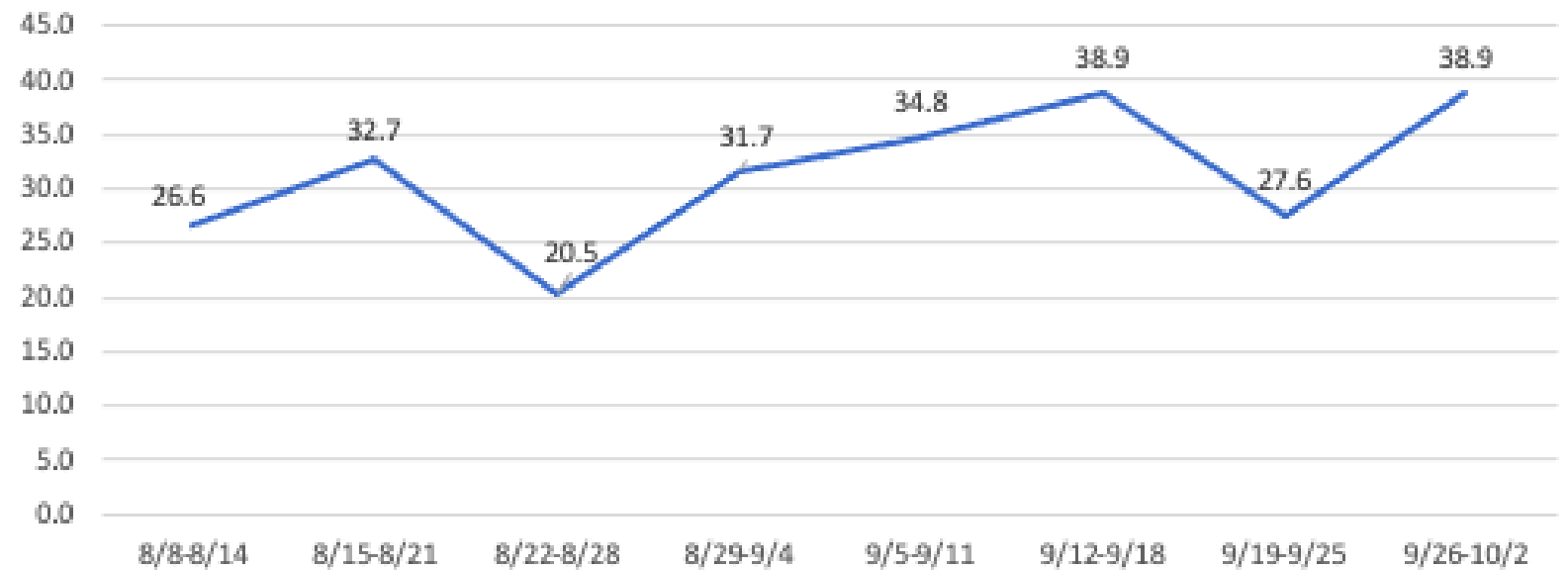
Total Positive Cases for Mono County Residents (last 30 d...

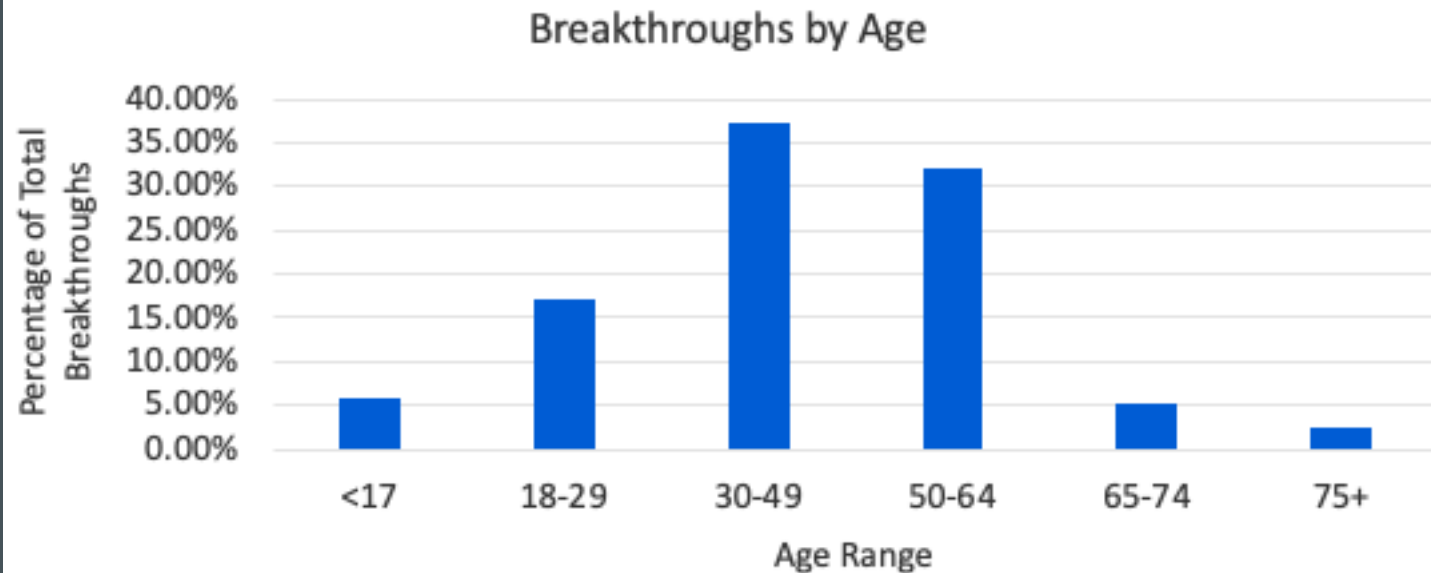
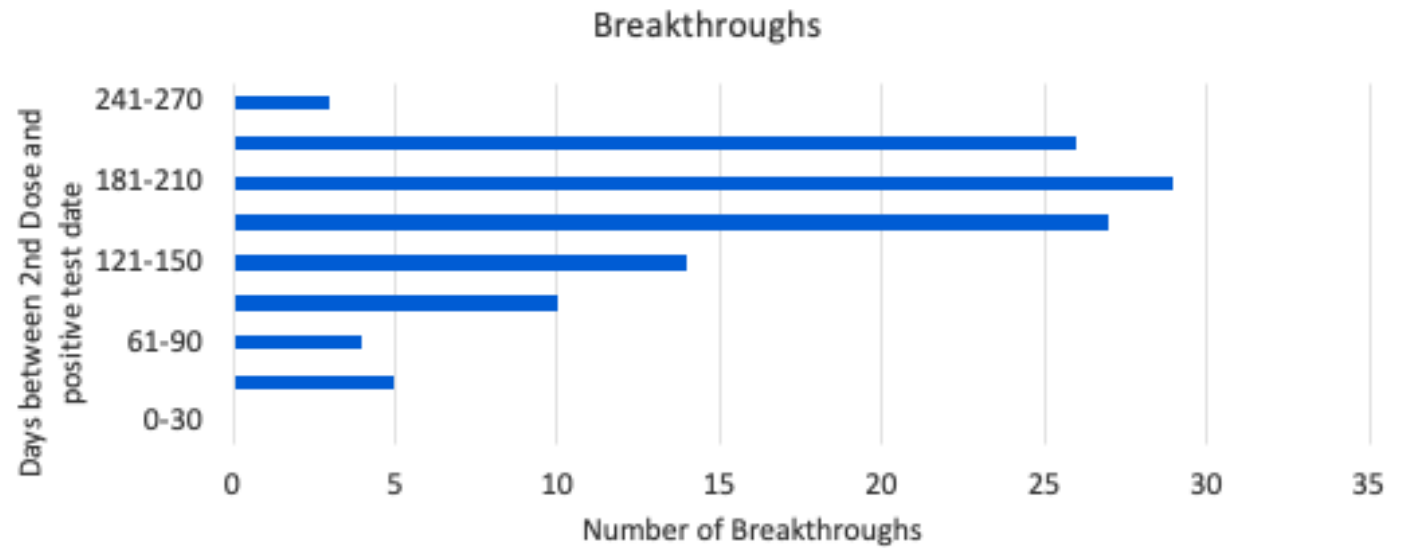

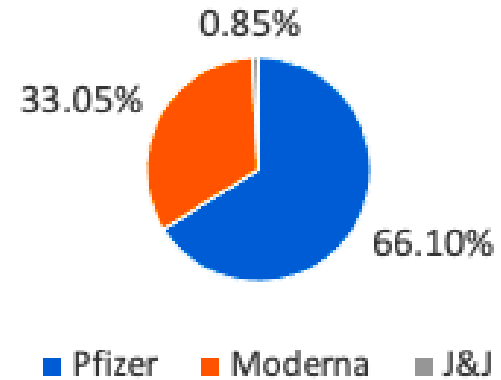
POST VACCINATION INFECTIONS (BREAKTHROUGH)

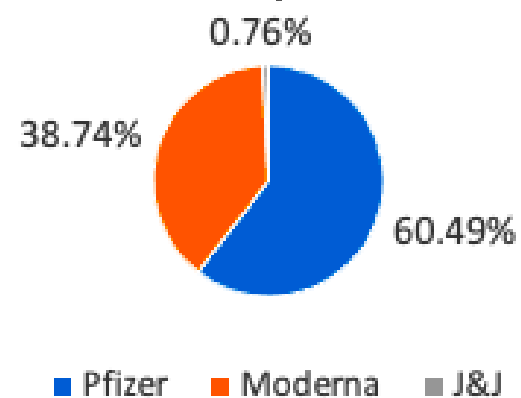

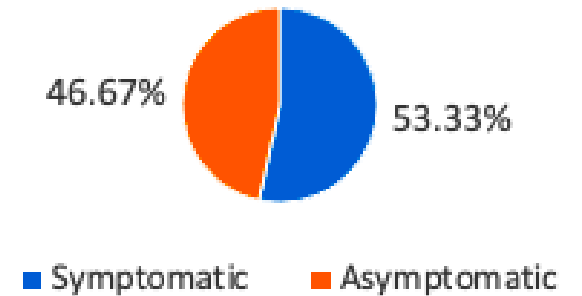
Breakthroughs by Brand

COVID VACCINE SCHOOL MANDATE

- California Becomes First State in Nation to Announce COVID-19 Vaccine Requirements for Schools:
 - *After implementing first-in-the-nation school masking and staff vaccination measures, California becomes the first state to announce plans to require student vaccinations – adding the COVID-19 vaccine to list of vaccinations required for school, such as the vaccines for measles, mumps, and rubella.*
 - *Students will be required to be vaccinated for in person learning starting the term following FDA full approval of the vaccine for their grade span (7-12 and K-6).*
 - *Vaccinations for 5 – 11-year-old expected to have EUA between Halloween and Thanksgiving.*

- Merck & Co. and partner Ridgeback Biotherapeutics LP said Monday they have filed an application asking U.S. health regulators to authorize their Covid-19 pill, the next step toward adding a long-sought drug for use at home.
- The filing comes shortly after [data from a late-stage study showed](#) that the antiviral drug, molnupiravir, cut the risk of hospitalization or death by about 50% in high-risk people with mild to moderate COVID-19.

BOOSTER SHOTS FOR THOSE WITH COMPROMISED IMMUNE SYSTEMS

- Active treatment for solid tumor and hematologic malignancies.
- Receipt of solid-organ transplant and taking immunosuppressive therapy.
- Receipt of CAR-T-cell or hematopoietic stem cell transplant (within 2 years of transplantation or taking immunosuppression therapy).
- Moderate or severe primary immunodeficiency (e.g., DiGeorge syndrome, Wiskott-Aldrich syndrome).
- Advanced or untreated HIV infection.
- Active treatment with high-dose corticosteroids (i.e., ≥ 20 mg prednisone or equivalent per day), alkylating agents, antimetabolites, transplant-related immunosuppressive drugs, cancer chemotherapeutic agents classified as severely immunosuppressive, tumor-necrosis (TNF) blockers, and other biologic agents that are immunosuppressive or immunomodulatory.
