Mono County Board of Supervisors Adopts Resolution Appointing Paul Roten as Public Works Director

MONO COUNTY, Calif. (August 1, 2022) — On July 12, 2022, the Mono County Board of Supervisors adopted a Resolution appointing Paul Roten as Mono County Public Works Director.
