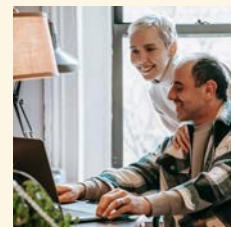

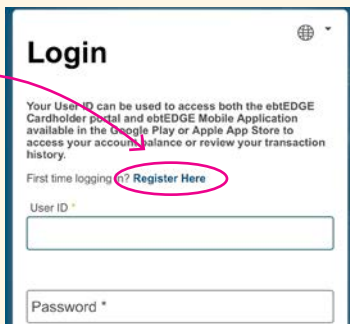

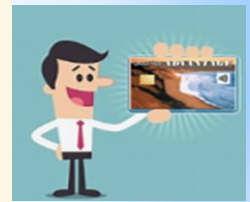

Upcoming Changes to How You Receive Your EDD Benefit Payments

We are changing the bank we use to issue debit cards for unemployment, disability, and Paid Family Leave benefit payments. Beginning February 15, 2024, benefits will no longer be issued to a Bank of America debit card. Instead, they will be issued to a new Money Network prepaid debit card.

Your Bank of America prepaid debit card is only active until April 15, 2024!

If You're Receiving Payments by Debit Card

After January 15, 2024, check your mail for your new Money Network Card. It will arrive in a plain, white, letter-sized envelope from the EDD, but with an Omaha, NE return address.

If you have received all the benefits on your claim or have returned to work and no longer receiving benefits by January 15, a new card will NOT be sent to you.

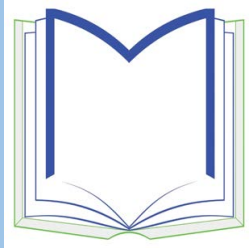

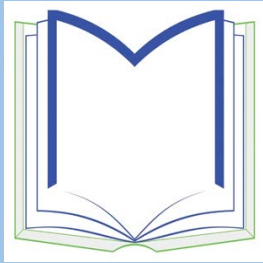

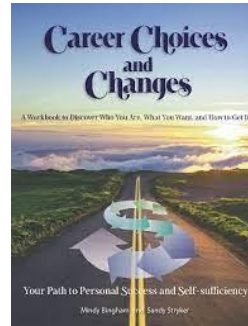
